A number of Evergreen Awards will be offered to outstanding students.

These awards will be selected by school staff based on the following criteria

- Academic Achievement which can be measured with high marks and/or credit completion and/or success in programming.
- **Citizenship** which can be measured by evidence of student efforts to promote the betterment of their school, community and the world.
- **Healthy Lifestyle** which can be measured by participation in school sporting activities, community sports/recreation, and/or personal healthy living choices.

Awards will be as follows:

- Grade 9: \$150 and a letter/certificate of recognition
- Grade 10: \$150 and a letter/certificate of recognition
- Grade 11: \$150 and a letter/certificate of recognition
- Grade 12: \$500 and a letter/certificate of recognition

Note: The number of awards per high school is related to enrolment

- up to 150 students two awards/grade
- 151 to 225 students three awards/grade
- 226 to 300 students four awards/grade

Graduation Address

Up to two (2) students per school will be awarded \$150 at the principals' discretion for the submission and delivery of an address/speech at the graduation ceremony.

Student Voice

The student selected from the Student Voice group to participate at Board meeting will be awarded \$500 at the discretion of the Superintendent.
