Evergreen School Division recognizes the importance of student voice. Students will be given opportunities to provide feedback on their experiences in Evergreen School Division classrooms and schools. Our students should feel known, heard and included.

Classroom Teachers

- Teachers will request student feedback on classroom experiences through feedback forms, conversations, class meetings, surveys etc.

Principals

- Principals (middle years and high schools) will have scheduled gatherings of student representatives at least twice per year to gather feedback and input on:
 - Classroom learning and the classroom learning environment(s)
 - School experiences and school environment

Superintendent

- The Superintendent and/or designate will periodically engage in these gatherings at each school.

Board

- The Board will hear student voice via:
 - Reporting by the Superintendent regarding student feedback
 - Student representation in school presentations.
