

# COVID-19 Screening Questions



## Symptom and exposure screening questions (check all that apply)

<b>A. Do you have a new onset, or worsening, of any ONE of the following symptoms?</b>		<b>Yes</b>	<b>No</b>
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Fever &gt; 38°C or subjective fever/ chills</li> <li>• Cough</li> <li>• Sore throat/ hoarse voice</li> <li>• Shortness of breath/ breathing difficulties</li> <li>• Loss of taste or smell</li> <li>• Vomiting or diarrhea for more than 24 hours</li> </ul>		
<b>If "yes" to any one of the above, DO NOT ENTER</b>			
<b>B. Do you have a new onset, or worsening, of any TWO of the following symptoms?</b>		<b>Yes</b>	<b>No</b>
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Runny nose</li> <li>• Muscle aches</li> <li>• Fatigue</li> <li>• Conjunctivitis (pink eye)</li> <li>• Headache</li> <li>• Skin rash of unknown cause</li> <li>• Nausea or loss of appetite</li> <li>• Poor feeding (if an infant)</li> </ul>		
<b>If "yes" to any two of the above, DO NOT ENTER *</b>			
<p>* If you have only one symptom in section B and it has been less than 24 hours since it started, stay home and avoid contact with others. Re-evaluate after 24 hours, and use the on-line COVID-19 Screening Tool. <a href="https://sharedhealthmb.ca/covid19/screening-tool/">https://sharedhealthmb.ca/covid19/screening-tool/</a>.</p>			
<b>Exposure history</b>		<b>Yes</b>	<b>No</b>
1.	Have you been in close contact (within 2 metres/ 6 feet for more than 10 minutes total over 24 hours) in the last 14 days with someone who has tested positive for COVID-19 (with a rapid antigen test or laboratory based test)? **		
2.	Have you traveled outside of Manitoba in the past 14 days and are required to self-isolate (quarantine)? ***		
3.	Has a member of your household had COVID-19 symptoms in the last 14 days? **		
4.	Are you waiting for COVID-19 test results?		
5.	Have you tested positive (with a rapid antigen test or laboratory based test) in the past 10 days?		
<b>If "yes" to any of the above, DO NOT ENTER. Take the online screening tool <a href="https://sharedhealthmb.ca/covid19/screening-tool/">https://sharedhealthmb.ca/covid19/screening-tool/</a></b>			

\*\* Exemptions are in place for close contacts, exposed individuals and household members if they have no symptoms AND are fully immunized or recently infected with COVID-19 (i.e. within the previous six months).

\*\*\* Exemptions from self-isolation (quarantine) orders for persons entering Manitoba include some essential workers and those who are fully immunized, if they have no symptoms. International travellers must follow federal self-isolation (quarantine) requirements.
