1. Transition Meetings (June)

- End of Year IEP Meetings (teachers, parent, resource teacher)
 - O Current teacher and team meet with incoming teacher for next school year
- Meetings with Student Support Team (Resource, Counsellor, Principal) and grade level teachers
 - Teachers bring completed <u>Student Transition Form</u>
- 2. IEP Mtgs. (Mid September / February / June)
 - For existing IEP's (or new Non funded IEP's)
 - o Includes Resource, Counsellor, Teacher, Parent, others (may include Principal)
- **3. Strong Beginnings** (End of September)
 - Complements info from June Transition Meetings
 - ELA / Math Assessments
 - Reading Fountas & Pinell
 - ₩ First Steps in Math
 - Other (at teachers' discretion)
- **4. Student Support Planning Meetings*** (First week of October and then 6 to 8 week intervals)
 - Teacher meets with Student Support Team (Resource, Counsellor, Principal)
 - Teacher brings data sources (i.e. Strong Beginnings, etc)
 - Student Support Planning Form
 - Group decides which Level(s) and in what domain(s) (academic, emotional, behavioural) students need support (i.e. Tier 1,2,3)
 - o BIP's
 - AEP's
 - New IEP's
 - Enrichment (i.e. Advanced Placement
- Targeted Interventions (math, reading, behavior)
- o AAP

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5. Student Services Meeting

- Monthly meetings between Resource Teacher, Counsellor, Principal
- Reviewing work at all Tiers (i.e. PBIS, current caseloads, interventions, emergent needs)

6. Professional Learning Communities (Monthly Meetings)

- Grade groups of teachers meet monthly for a half day
- They discuss school plan implementation at the classroom level
- Share assessment data, develop learning strategies and review interventions

7. School Planning (May)


• Stakeholders (teachers, support staff, students*, parents*) meet to discuss progress of current priorities and identify new priorities and strategies if any
