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As a pivotal function of the governance model, the Board of Trustees monitors the effectiveness of the school division by receiving regular reporting on the following system goals for Evergreen School Division:

- 1. Provide students with relevant and engaging learning experience.
- 2. Prepare to become contributing citizens.
- 3. Provide inclusive, safe, respectful and caring learning environments for all students and staff.
- 4. Provide quality learning opportunities for all students.
- 5. Provide for the personal, social, physical and mental well-being of all students.
- 6. Provide early learning programming and interventions.
- 7. Achieve high graduation rates.
- 8. Enhance successful academic and social transitions for all students.
- 9. Attain high levels of student, parent and staff satisfaction.
- 10. Foster positive relationships among students, staff and community.
- 11. Provide clean, well-maintained and safe physical environments.
- 12. Allocate resources in keeping with division plans and values.
- 13. Comply with legislative requirements.

When measuring the success of its System Goals, the Board will consider: Student achievement and social emotional learning as measured through a variety of assessment indicators, as well as levels of student, parent and staff satisfaction and engagement.

Further, a Superintendent's report to the Board will be prepared for every regular board meeting and will consist of, at a minimum, the following:

- 1. Report of significant programming, Provincial and education plan information
- 2. Monthly cheque register
- 3. Accounts receivable balance and analysis
- 4. Staffing reports
